National Club

Southside Annie's

The biggest day of the year for Libad's is their annual bike run and summer bash for Lenny Oliviera that takes place at the beginning of August. Libad's main attraction is the mechanical bull that is available for anyone brave enough to ride. You can also try to win \$25 for being the best at Smug Bastards Trivia on Tuesday nights.
