## The South Coast Hot Jobs List - 3 October 2013



- 1. Quality Control Inspector #3074132 Quality Control Inspector needed for a local manufacturer. Must have at least 10 years of experience in quality control within the manufacturing field, a good "eye" for quality and familiarity with military specs would be helpful. Selected candidate will be inspecting high end products/high end materials.
- 2. Part Time Dishwasher #3082667 Part time dishwasher position available. Kitchen knowledge, experience preferred. Hours will vary depending on functions and events. Average hours to start will be 4-12 hours (Wed- Sat).
- 3. Cashier #3091704 Responsible for providing excellent

customer service, efficiently and accurately completing sales and service transactions at the cash wraps, as well as handle customer issues that may arise on the sales floor.

**4. Administrative Specialist #3091711** — Under general supervision of the Purchasing Agent, performs a variety of complex technical work to provide cost effective purchasing procedures in compliance with Massachusetts law.

Must have strong organizational skills. Ability to accurately record and maintain records. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, supervisors, other departments, officials and the public. Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing. Attention to detail and good proofreading skills. Demonstrated computer literacy using standard word processing, spreadsheet software and networked databases.

Graduation from a college or university with a Bachelor's degree in public administration, political science, human resources, business management, or a closely related field, and at least three years' previous related experience; or any equivalent combination of experience and training. Prior experience with the Munis financial software program desired. Massachusetts Certified Public Procurement Officer (MCPPO) certification preferred, or the willingness to become certified.

The City of New Bedford has a Residency Requirement and Mandatory CORI background check per City Council Ordinance effective May 14, 2013.
