Massachusetts State Police investigating fatal crash in Amesbury

Yesterday at approximately 9:00 p.m., Troopers assigned to the Newbury Barracks responded to multiple reports of a single vehicle crash on Route 495 Northbound, north of Exit 54 in Amesbury.

Preliminary investigation by Trooper Michael Crowley indicates that Sabrina Milone, 21, of Garden City N.Y. was traveling on Route 495 Northbound in a 2015 Jeep Wrangler when, for reasons

still under investigation, she traveled off the right side of the roadway and crashed. Milone was transported Anna Jaques Hospital where she succumbed to her injuries. Milone was the sole occupant of the vehicle.

This crash remains under investigation by Troopers assigned to the Newbury Barracks, the Collision Analysis Reconstruction Section, and Troopers assigned to the Essex County District Attorney's Office. Amesbury Fire, EMS, and Police Departments also assisted on scene.

Two men die in rollover crash on Route 95 in Attleboro

UPDATE: There is now a second confirmed fatality related to the crash on Route 95 in Attleboro on Saturday, Both deceased victims are adult males who were occupants of the van that rolled over.

The van was operating as part of a tour group which caters to the Polish/American community. It is believed that this tour may have picked up passengers in Philadelphia, P.A., Trenton, Linden, and Wallington, N.J., and New York City, with a destination of various sites in Massachusetts.

Identification of the occupants of the van is ongoing.

A rollover crash of a passenger van on Route 95 in Attleboro Saturday morning resulted in one death and ten seriously injured.

Preliminary investigation by Trooper Michael Bartucca indicates that at about 11:05 a.m., a 2004 Ford Econoline van

was traveling on Route 95 Northbound in the area of Exit 3 when it was struck by a 2018 Toyota RAV 4, which was also traveling northbound in an adjacent lane. Both vehicles then crossed over the median. The van rolled over and crashed in the southbound travel lanes and the Toyota, which did not roll over, came to rest in the breakdown lane on the southbound side. All eleven people in the van were ejected during the rollover.

The occupants of the van were transported to Rhode Island Hospital for treatment. One person in the van has since been pronounced deceased. The operator of the Toyota, a 32-year-old East Providence, Rhode Island woman, was transported to RI Hospital for treatment of minor injuries.

This crash remains under investigation with assistance from the State Police Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section, Crime Scene Services Section, Troop H Detectives, and Troopers assigned to the Bristol County District Attorney's Office. No charges have been filed at this time.

State Police were assisted on scene by Attleboro, North Attleboro, Pawtucket, Cumberland, Central Falls, and Seekonk Fire and EMS, and Attleboro, North Attleboro, and Plainville PD, as well as MassDOT.

16-year old killed in single vehicle crash in Andover

A single-vehicle rollover crash on Route 93 in Andover Saturday resulted in the death of a 16-year old boy.

Preliminary investigation by Trooper David Bergeron indicates

that at about 5:00 p.m., a 16-year-old operator was traveling on Route 93 Northbound, north of Route 495 in Andover in a 2018 Mitsubishi SUV when, for reasons still under investigation, the operator lost control of the vehicle, causing it to travel off the right side of the roadway before rolling over and crashing into a signpost. The operator and sole occupant was initially transported to Lawrence General Hospital before being transferred to Leahy Hospital in Burlington for treatment of serious injuries. He passed away on Sunday.

The cause of this crash remains under investigation with assistance from the State Police Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section and Crime Scene Services Section.

State Police were assisted on scene by Andover Fire and EMS. Per department policy, the identity of the juvenile is being withheld.

Massachusetts State Police investigating fatal crash in Attleboro

A rollover crash of a passenger van on Route 95 in Attleboro yesterday morning resulted in two deaths and ten seriously injured.

Preliminary investigation by Trooper Michael Bartucca

indicates that at about 11:05 a.m., a 2004 Ford Econoline van was traveling on Route 95 Northbound in the area of Exit 3 when it was struck by a 2018 Toyota RAV 4, which was also traveling northbound in an adjacent lane. Both vehicles then crossed over the median.

The van rolled over and crashed in the southbound travel lanes and the Toyota, which did not roll over, came to rest in the breakdown lane on the southbound side. All eleven people in the van were ejected during the rollover. The van was operating as part of a tour group which caters to the Polish/American community. It is believed that this tour may have picked up passengers in Philadelphia, P.A., Trenton, Linden, and Wallington, N.J., and New York City, with a destination of various sites in Massachusetts.

The occupants of the van were transported to Rhode Island Hospital for treatment. Two people in the van have since been pronounced deceased. The operator of the Toyota, a 32-year-old East Providence, Rhode Island woman, was transported to RI Hospital for treatment of minor injuries.

This crash remains under investigation with assistance from the State Police Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section, Crime Scene Services Section, Troop H Detectives, and Troopers assigned to the Bristol County District Attorney's Office. No charges have been filed at this time.

State Police were assisted on scene by Attleboro, North Attleboro, Pawtucket, Cumberland, Central Falls, and Seekonk Fire and EMS, and Attleboro, North Attleboro, and Plainville PD, as well as MassDOT.

Identification of the occupants of the van is ongoing. Further information will be released when available and appropriate.

Massachusetts State Police investigating double-fatal motorcycle crash in O'Neill Tunnel

Massachusetts State Police are investigating a double fatal crash involving two motorcycles that occurred early this morning in the Thomas P. O'Neill Tunnel in Boston.

Preliminary investigation by Troopers assigned to the State Police-Tunnels Barracks indicates that a group of several motorcyclists were riding on Route 93 northbound shortly after 2 a.m. For reasons that are still under investigation, two of the operators lost control of their motorcycles in the tunnel at Exit 23 and crashed, each suffering fatal injuries. Both were determined to be deceased on scene.

At least two other motorcycle operators who were with the victims remained on scene.

The victims are young adult males. Their identities are not being released at this time; next-of-kin notifications are ongoing.

Two lanes remain closed at this time to facilitate the ongoing crash investigation. One lane remains open to traffic.

The facts and circumstances of the crash remain under investigation by the State Police-Tunnels, State Police Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section, State Police Crime Scene Services Section, and State Police detectives. Boston Fire and Boston EMS also responded to the crash.

Habitual Offender Sentenced to Prison for Seekonk Robbery

A habitual offender who was convicted this week of a Seekonk armed robbery was sentenced to serve seven years in state prison, Bristol County District Attorney Thomas M. Quinn III announced.

Sidney Ingram, 41, of Dorchester, pleaded guilty this week in Fall River Superior Court to an indictment charging him with armed robbery (habitual offender).

In October of 2014, the defendant entered a Staples office supply store in Seekonk and picked up numerous "Beats by Dre" headphones and an Apple IPAD. The defendant calmly walked to the counter and told the worker he had a gun and then left the store without paying. He got in a car and sped off.

The defendant was stopped by police in Warren, RI later that same evening after a BOLD issued for his vehicle. Police found all the stolen items in the car.

He spent several months in a Rhode Island jail after refusing to agree to be extradited back to Massachusetts, which caused lengthy delays in the prosecution of the case.

The defendant has been convicted and served jail time on at least three separate robberies in Bristol County, Norfolk County, and Middlesex County.

"The defendant is a career criminal who did everything he could to hinder and obstruct his return to Mass to face these charges. Working with the Rhode Island Attorney General's office, we were eventually able to have him returned to

Massachusetts and be held accountable for another crime of violence. This is another dangerous defendant who does not belong out in the street,” District Attorney Quinn said.
