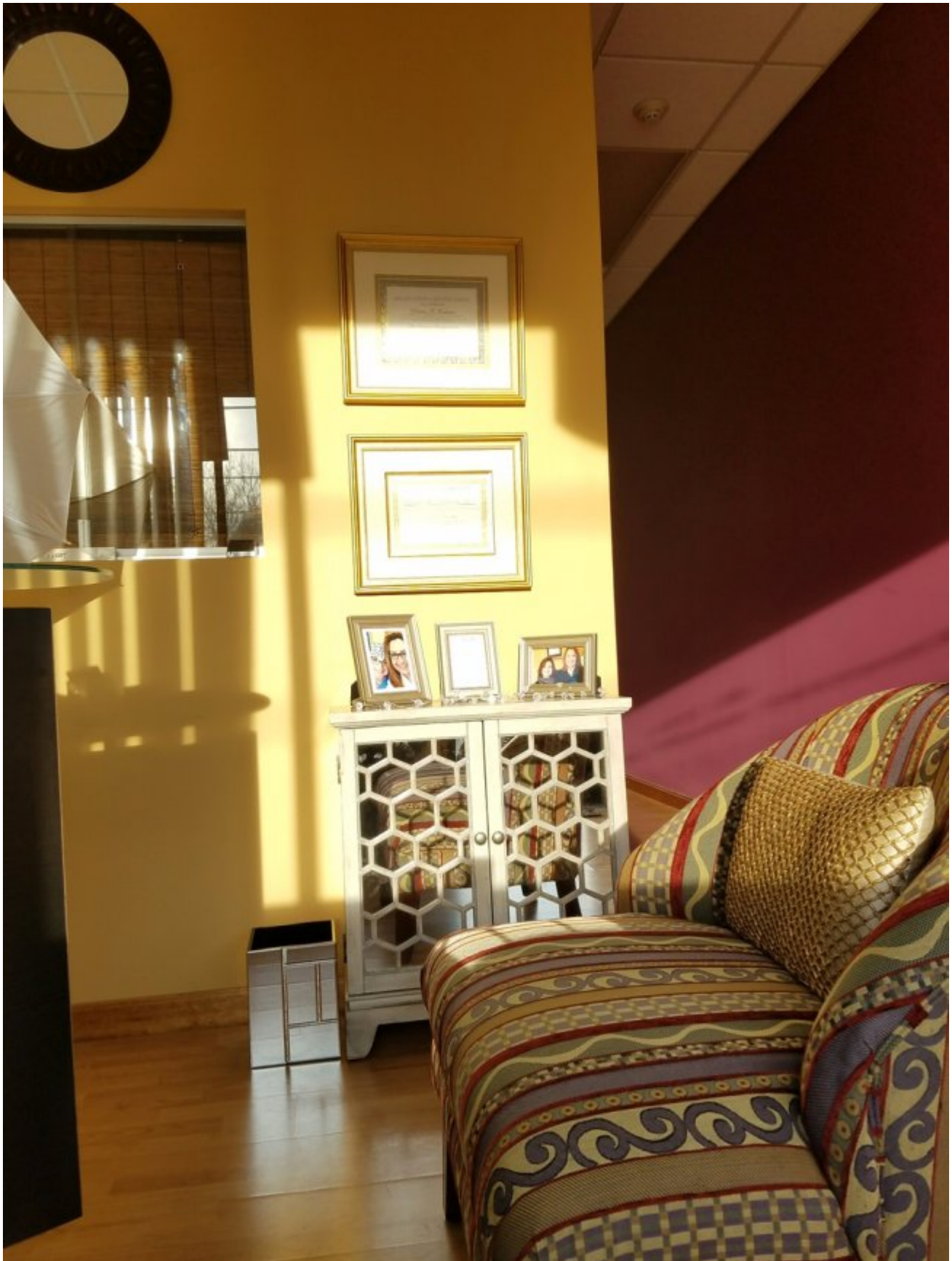

Next came the tedious task of meeting all the criteria to obtain a body art permit from the town. It was during her two year internship that she met Sonia Nyren. Sonia is a native Brazilian who speaks fluent English and Portuguese who Patricia immediately realized had the same passion for this type of work that she did. They hit it off immediately and Patricia asked Sonia to join her. Sonia, a licensed Level 1 Esthetician then formed Southcoast Skincare and created a beautiful space in the 3 room suite. Sonia offers facials, microderm abrasion, eyebrow design/ eyebrow henna application, as well as many other services. Non latex gloves are used and topical anesthetics and pigments are only purchased from USA companies with the highest standards. Universal precautions and aseptic technique are used, all needles are disposable. As important as all these things are, customer service is equally as important. Clients are treated in a respectful and dignified manner and with utmost respect.

When asked what sets Southcoast Dermalgraphics apart from

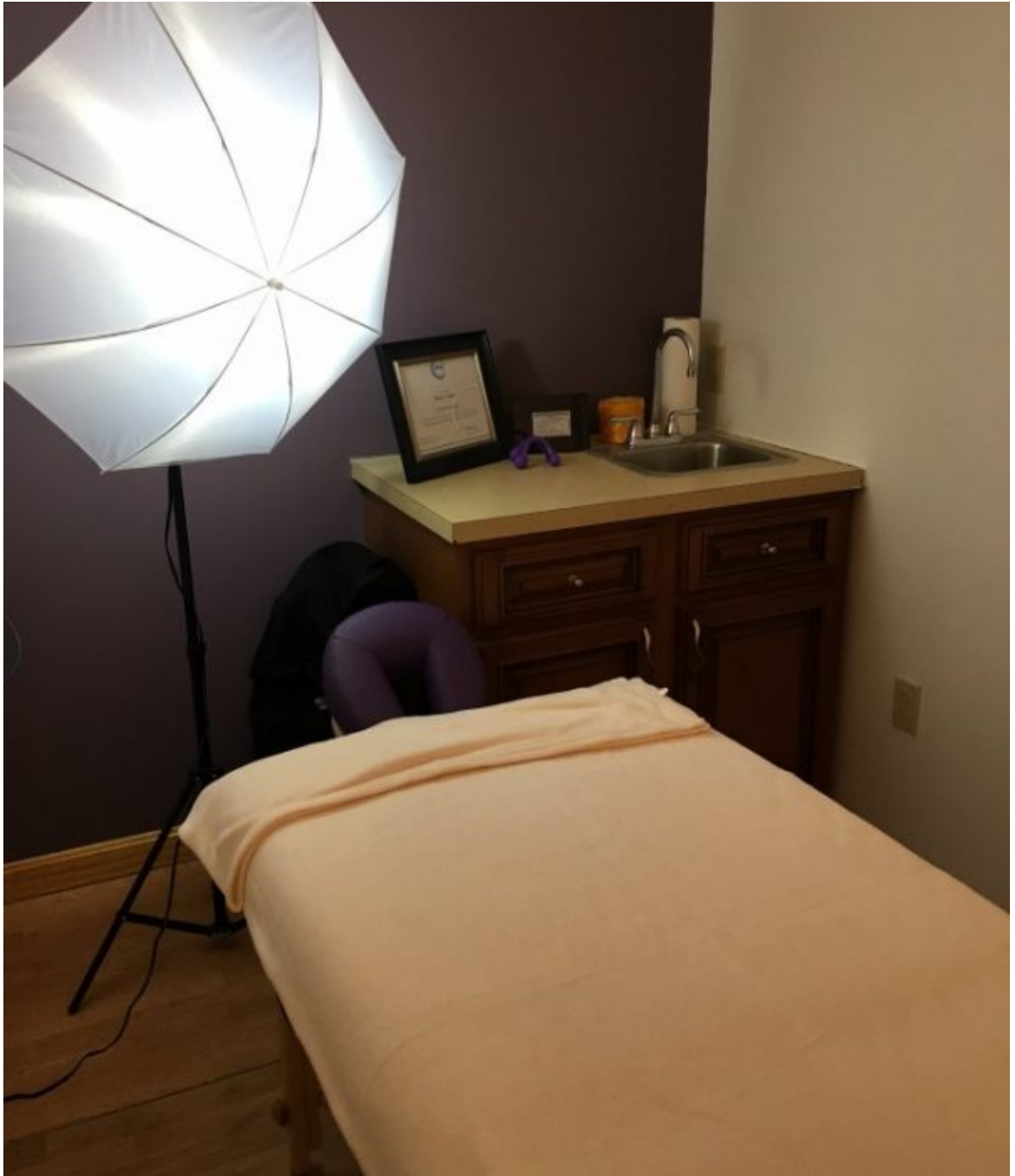

Route 18 southbound closed on Tuesday, April 18th into Wednesday morning

Route 18 Southbound in New Bedford is scheduled to be closed on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m Wednesday. It was previously scheduled to start on Monday.

The closure is necessary to allow for paint and median work at Wamsutta Railroad Bridge on Route 18.

A detour will be in place for all motor vehicle traffic as follows:

I-195 Eastbound to Route 18 Southbound:

Take Exit 16 (Washburn St)

Take a right at the bottom of the ramp onto Washburn Street

Take a right onto Belleville Avenue

Take a left onto Coggeshall Street

Take a left onto Purchase Street

Continue on Purchase Street which becomes Foster Street

Continue on Foster Street which becomes North 6th Street

Take a left onto Union Street

The end of Union Street intersects with Route 18

I-195 Westbound to Route 18 Southbound:

Take Exit 17 (Coggeshall St)

Take a left at the bottom of the ramp onto Coggeshall Street

Take a left onto Purchase Street

Continue on Purchase Street which becomes Foster Street

Continue on Foster Street which becomes North 6th Street

Take a left onto Union Street

The end of Union Street intersects with Route 18

Repeat New Bedford heroin trafficker sentenced to 5-7 years in prison

A 26-year-old New Bedford heroin trafficker with a lengthy history of dealing drugs in and around the Whaling City was convicted last week and sentenced to serve five to seven years in state prison, District Attorney Thomas M. Quinn III announced.

Javier Natal pleaded guilty in Fall River Superior Court last Friday to a single-count indictment charging him with trafficking in heroin.

On February 24, 2015, there was a search warrant executed at this defendant's home in New Bedford. The search warrant was granted after the police received information that the defendant was running a heroin distribution service at 912 County Street, Apt 3.

When the defendant was attempting to leave the apartment in his car, he was stopped by New Bedford Police and brought back to the apartment. Inside, police found 195 grams of heroin in a teddy bear, along with scales, baggies and around \$1,500 in cash..

The defendant has been convicted of drug distribution related charges on at least three other occasions and has served multiple stints in jail.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jeanne Veenstra and the prison sentence was handed down by Judge Raffi Yessayan.

"This defendant is a repeat drug dealer who has been contributing to the ongoing opiate problem in our

communities,” District Attorney Quinn said. “This state prison sentence is appropriate and justified.”
