- July 11: KG Express "The KG Express" is a High Energy R&B band from New England with top notch vocals and seasoned musicians from New York to Cape Cod.
- July 18: Johnny's Basement John, Mike and Chuck have been playing together off and on for over 20 years. Chris is the newest addition to the band playing the drums. They play everything from Aerosmith, Led Zeppelin and Kiss to Maroon 5, Train and Fallout Boy. There's something for everyone.
- July 25: Boston Soul Revue with special guest FOXX Dream Girls Boston Soul Revue plays the timeless classics, everyone's favorite dance hits of the 60's and 70's.
