Upon arrival, Capt. Moyer found a female resident in active labor and the team determined a field birth was imminent. Shortly after that at 6:06am, the patient, with the team's support delivered a healthy baby girl.

Today, the family came down to the station to say thanks and allow the team a reunion with the family.
