Here are the Hot Jobs from the Greater New Bedford Career Center as of May 7th, 2014:

1. Solar Installer #4043437 Position available to install Solar panels and rackings on roofs and ground mount systems. Must be able to work on roofs and must have own transportation. Experience not necessary. Must have a H.S.Diploma and must be at least 18 years of age.

2. Medical Benefits Rep #4043444 Responsible for processing all incoming Massachusetts Managed Care mail. Orients all new patients and re-enrolled PCC, file documentation and all paper work related to Mass Health Managed Care. Input all Mass Health, Managed Care information into the computer system. Contact all Mass Managed Care patients via telephone and mail regarding establishment with the Health Center periodically. Responsible for inputting approval information into the MSI

system in order to update the insurance carrier information. Administrative resource to the health center for assisting clients with eligibility criteria for Masshealth, by completing the Medical Benefits Request. To assist patients with enrollment in the centers preferred managed care plan and following up on patient compliance and understanding of managed health care.

3. Warehouse/Freezer Worker #3973123 Positions can begin as early as 5:00am to 5:00pm or 6:00 pm. Overtime available in peak of the season. Some weekends are necessary.

Must have warehouse experience especially in the seafood industry. Frozen warehouse experience is a plus. Must be able to drive a forklift and pallet truck. OSHA certification is a PLUS. Some non CDL driving required to go from plant to plant. Bilingual is also a plus. Employer needs to fill position ASAP.
