Mattapoisett police arrested breaking and entering suspect

After a brief search the suspect identified as Maxx Phillips, age 30 of 2511 Cranberry Highway, Wareham was taken into custody. A search warrant was later executed on a residence in Mattapoisett and all of the stolen property was recovered. Plymouth County K9 and BCI assisted with the Investigation.
