The Whaler's Attic and Pantry opened in May 2016 as a result of the initiative of staff volunteers — school counselors and Family Engagement Center staff at New Bedford High. Since the 2016-2017 school year began, the Whaler's Attic has provided clothing and food to more than 30 students in need, identified largely through staff referrals.

Non-perishable canned goods, packaged meals, soaps, deodorants, toothpaste, toilet paper and other toiletries are needed as well. Gift certificate donations are also accepted to purchase items.

All donations are acknowledged and a tax deduction form is provided. The support of the community is integral to sustaining the work of the Whaler's Attic and Pantry volunteers.
