- 2 Members of this team have a 4.0 GPA and are tied for 1st in the class of 2023

Athletically, these girls are as talented and gifted as they come:

- 9 of the 11 girls play 2 or 3 sports
- Many of them have received individual recognition including, but not limited to, SEC-All Star, Standard-Times All-Star, Pre-Season Boston Globe Recognition.

During a shortened season (Due to Covid) these 11 girls showed up every day, following every new protocol put in place, and had two goals in mind; to get better every day, and compete for an SEC Championship.
