1. PRODUCTION WORKER #1752813 – Responsibilities include but are not limited to: Preparing work to be packaged, priced and shipped according to customer specifications. Operating

package machine. Clean up at end of day. Must be able to communicate in English and have good work ethic. Job is not difficult but requires a responsible person. high school or equivalent.

2. ASSISTANT STEWARD POSITION #1752809 – Responsibilities include but not limited to: Assisting the Steward in the planning, directing and coordinating of the food services, preparing menu, controlling costs and making inspection. Selected applicant will perform Steward's duties in his/her absence. Must have a High school Diploma or GED, ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing and willingness to learn.
