New Bedford Library Embarks on Strategic Planning Process

The Director and Trustees of the New Bedford Public Library are working with a library services consultant to develop a new strategic plan that will serve as a blueprint for service enhancements for the New Bedford Free Public Library for the next several years. The strategic plan will set the course for the library's future for a 3–5 year period and will ensure that it continues to meet the evolving needs of the community

As part of the strategic planning process the library will host a public forum to gather input from community members on the features they want and need from the library system. The information gathered at this event will be combined with the data collected from the library's community partners, trustees and staff to develop a mission and vision statement and to establish goals and multi-year objectives.
