

# New Bedford Police Department reminds resident to “Lock It Up!” after spate of car breaks, thefts

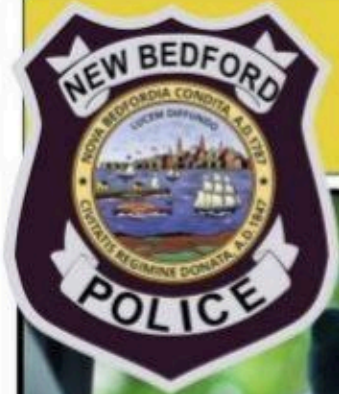
“\*\*\*LOCK IT UP\*\*\*”

- Do not leave valuable items visible in your car, including purses and wallets.
- Make sure your car is locked.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- If you see any suspicious activity or a break-in in progress please call 911 immediately!

**Call 911 if you see suspicious activities such as:**

- Pulling on door handles
- Looking into car windows
- Lookouts.
- Nervous—looking around, moving slowly or quickly.
- Checking for car alarms by bumping or hitting the window or bumpers for sensitivity.
