New Bedford's Alma del Mar Raises \$1,000 for Joe Andruzzi Foundation

Former Patriots three-time Super Bowl Champion offensive guard Joe Andruzzi spent time with scholars at Alma del Mar Charter School's Sarah D. Ottiwell Campus on Friday as appreciation for the school community's fundraising efforts for the player's charitable foundation.
