

# **Non-owner occupied buildings may soon be required to post contact signs**

This Thursday, the New Bedford City Council will vote on Mayor Mitchell's request to change an ordinance that will impact owners of non-owner occupied buildings in New Bedford. If approved, these owners in New Bedford will be required "to post the contact information of the property owner and manager or agent in a conspicuous place in the building's main public area." Failure to do so will result in a \$300 daily fine.

If passed, the signs posted on the properties will make it easier for City officials to contact the owner if there are problems with the property. Here's a look at the draft ordinance change:
