The Family Advocate will be responsible for recruiting and enrolling eligible children for Head Start services. He/she

follows procedures for enrollment, completes forms, verifies eligibility, and enters family data in the computer. Home visits and survey forms are completed to engage families in partnerships to improve and support the condition and quality of family life, while also encouraging parents to be involved in their child's education experience and school readiness. The Advocate participates in case management meetings to ensure that quality services are delivered to each child and family and maintains a record of referrals, supportive services, and outcomes. The Advocate will facilitate positive relationships between the Head Start Program, children, families, and community agencies and services.
