

Snow, Sleet and Rain to Impact Monday Evening Commute

The rain that we've been getting today will turn to snow showers this afternoon before mixing with rain again. Then it will turn to all snow after 3pm through the evening commute and into the evening. We're fortunate that the air and ground temperatures are above freezing for the duration of the storm, but overnight wet surfaces will freeze.

Here is the full 36 hour forecast.

Rain before 2pm, then snow, possibly mixed with rain between 2pm and 3pm, then snow after 3pm. High near 39. North wind around 10 mph, with gusts as high as 22 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. Total daytime snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches possible.

Tonight

Snow likely, mainly before 9pm. Cloudy during the early evening, then gradual clearing, with a low around 28. Northwest wind 8 to 11 mph, with gusts as high as 25 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New snow accumulation of less than a half inch possible.

Tuesday

Mostly sunny, with a high near 42. West wind 8 to 11 mph, with gusts as high as 22 mph.

Tuesday Night will see increasing clouds, with a low around 23. West wind 5 to 9 mph.

Wednesday

Snow likely, mainly after 4pm. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 37. Light and variable wind becoming southeast 5 to 8 mph in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation is 70%. New snow accumulation of less than one inch possible

As always drive cautiously, put on your headlights and slow

down.
