

- Electrical repair and replace power switches, fuses, wall sockets and fixtures. Troubleshoot electrically powered fixtures and appliances such as ceiling lights, ceiling fans, climate control systems, and garage doors.
- Carpentry— complete all tasks involved in the following: repair and remodel doors, cabinets, windows, sliding glass doors, subfloors, drywall, crown moldings, trim carpentry, etc.

- Appliances— diagnose and repair issues with washers, dryers, refrigerators, dishwashers, stoves, garbage disposals, etc.
- Masonry— repair minor masonry work such as chimneys, foundations, walkways, stairs, stone walls, etc.
- Perform snow removal and de-icing at the facilities as needed
- Support with troubleshooting problems experienced by other members of the facilities team.
