Two men arrested after home invasion in Northborough, MA

At 9:14 a.m., the second suspect was found in the woods adjacent to Hayes Memorial Drive and taken into custody, pictured in the photo being taken out of the woods by MSP STOP Team Trooper Anthony Pagliaroni and MSP K-9 Section Trooper Brian McKenna.

The suspects were booked by local police, who are handling the follow-up investigation. A great team effort by MSP and local officers.
