## Wareham police charge woman with OUI, driving without a license

On Tuesday, July 31, at about 1:00 a.m., Officers Nate Aronson observed a vehicle driving erratically on Sandwich Road and pulled it over on Main Street.

After an investigation, Officer Aronson arrested the operator who had identified herself under a false name, for operating the under the influence of liquor, operating to endanger, fail to stop at a stop sign, speeding and marked lanes violation.

Arriving at the station with the arrestee, Officer Zina Kelsch immediately recognized the suspect as Shaunelle Black, 34, of Wareham.
