There will be 5-7 panelists who have followed different academic paths, to provide a wide variety of resources for

current NBHS students to make informed decisions about their future plans and how to begin preparing.

Topics will include how to get the most out of applications and college visits; choosing a school based on its offerings, size and locations; navigating the financial aid process including the FAFSA, grants, scholarships and loans; the transition to college life including academic and social life; and opportunities in the workforce, armed forces and summer employment/internships for high school graduates.
