Founded by Artistic Director Larry Keigwin, Keigwin + Company will honor what would be Bernstein's 100th birthday with a dynamic program that showcases two of his most iconic works: "On the Waterfront" and "On the Town — Suite." Originally commissioned by the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts and the National Symphony Orchestra, Waterfront & Episodes combine the company's virtuosity with Keigwin's keen musicality.

The performance will also include audience favorite Love Songs (2006), a romantic and playful series of duets highlighting different aspects of love that unfolds to classics by Aretha Franklin, Roy Orbison, and Nina Simone. Keigwin + Company will round out their program with Portraits (2004), intimate solos that highlight Keigwin's unique ability to showcase each dancer's strengths and distinct personalities.

Keigwin + Companywas founded in 2003 by Artistic Director Larry Keigwin and premiered at Joyce Soho the same year. The company creates and presents Keigwin's electrifying brand of contemporary dance that includes the acclaimed large-scale community project, Bolero, which has been commissioned in seven communities across the country, and Runaway (2008), a fashion-inspired choreographic ride, proclaimed "a thrilling coup d'theater" by James Wolcott of Vanity Fair.
